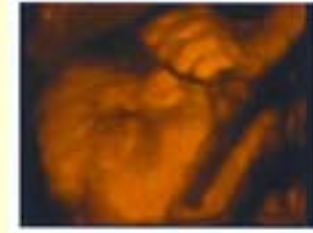

Imagine meeting your baby in the womb months before birth. That's the once-in-a-lifetime experience of 4D ultrasound, allowing you to see an up-close 3D image of your baby live on video—right down to the hairs on his head. Expectant parents, along with grandparents and other relatives who join in for the viewing, are often excited about getting a sneak peek of what their new addition to the family looks like. Best of all, 4D ultrasound offers a chance to watch a baby's movements in the uterus—from touching her face to kicking his feet.

Expectant parents and their families can often be seen grinning from ear to ear during a 4D ultrasound session—especially when they see their baby's face for the first time. Emotions run high throughout the session as the baby is brought to life in great detail on screen. Watching the baby's expressions and body movements are certainly highlights of the event.

"This is amazing. She is just so real. I wouldn't miss this for anything in the world. She's got your nose—identical isn't it! She looks just like your baby pictures...I can't get over how full her cheeks are...Look at that perfect little hand." —proud grandparent

Frequently Asked Questions:

What is 4D ultrasound?

4D is basically a three-dimensional image set in motion. When you choose to have a 4D ultrasound, you're seeing your baby's movements live on video. Important to note is the fact that this service is for your family's viewing pleasure and is NOT used as a diagnostic tool.

What do we get to take home?

During your session, the 4D ultrasound technician will record the experience and prepare a DVD and two sets of photos (both color and black and white) for you to take home. These are perfect mementos to share with family and friends. Consider it your baby's first portrait AND video debut.

What is the cost?

Unfortunately, medical insurance does not cover 4D ultrasound services. The cost is \$175. Sometimes grandparents are happy to treat the parents to this exciting experience, especially when they are invited to come watch the session. Payment is due at the time of service.

What about twins?

The 4D ultrasound package at Bay Area Physicians for Women is based on single pregnancies. Multiples are charged separately because each baby is individually imaged and video recorded.

When should I make my appointment?

Expectant mothers can have the 4D ultrasound performed between 26 and 32 weeks, however, we find that the optimal time is 28 weeks. We ask that patients arrive at Bay Area Physicians for Women at least 15 minutes in advance of their appointment time. Ask your nurse for more information.

Do I have to be a Bay Area Physicians patient to get a 4D ultrasound here?

You do NOT have to be our patient to schedule a 4D ultrasound appointment with us. We welcome the general public to our office for this experience, and please feel free to recommend family and friends.
